COUNTY OF DAUPHIN PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FY 2023 HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM GRANT August 26, 2025

A public hearing will be held at the Dauphin County Office of Community & Economic Development, 2 South 2nd Street, Room 124, Harrisburg, PA on September 17, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the public hearing is to present a Substantial Amendment to Dauphin County's Annual Action Plan FY 2023. The County's allocation for the FY 2023 CDBG program was \$1,425,028.00

Dauphin County is proposing to revise an activity in the Annual Action Plan FY 2023. Highspire Borough was awarded \$156,970.00 for their Hanover Street Roadway Rehabilitation project which came under budget. Dauphin County proposes to fund an additional activity in Highspire Borough. Race Street and Lumber Street in Highspire Borough serve as a major trucking corridor for industrial businesses and the local community. Both streets are crossed by a Norfolk Southern rail line. The crossings have severely deteriorated and have resulted in a health, safety and welfare issue for the Borough. The purpose of the project is to remove the existing rail and ties in order to repair the roadway. It is proposed that the unexpended funds in the amount of \$42,450.82 be used toward this project. A draft of the amended plan can be found on the Dauphin County Community & Economic Development web site.

The purpose of this notice and public hearing is to discuss the changes of this plan and to afford citizens the opportunity to comment upon elements of the program and action plan. (TDD users: Pennsylvania Telecommunications Center: 7-1-1)

Citizen participation is considered to be a key ingredient to the success of the program and is encouraged by the county commissioners.
