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Event Type Definitions

Residential Multi-family – A structure that contains 3 or more residential units.

High Life – Any location that poses multiple life threats due to difficulty exiting or lack of mobility of the inhabitants. Churches, hospitals, large apartment complexes, lodging locations, nursing homes, schools, etc.

High Rise – A structure that is too tall for adequate fire control from ground-based aerial ladders, elevating platforms, or towers. Locally defined as 4 or more stories.

Mixed-Use Occupancy – A building type that contains more than one occupancy group, such as commercial and residential.

Parking Garage – A structure constructed specifically for parking vehicles where fire apparatus access will be limited due to the building construction features. These structures may be freestanding or part of another building/structure.

Large Fire – Agricultural products, bulk cardboard, landfill, lumber pallets, bulk mulch, oil pumping units, railroad ties, bulk tire dump, etc.

Small Fire - BBQ grill, bleachers, bonfire, doghouse, dumpster, fence, garbage can, mailbox, outhouse, playground equipment, trash, tree, tree house, etc.

Unknown Injuries – Fire department response for accidents with unknown injuries is reserved for use in areas without 24-hour municipal police departments.

Small Aircraft – Number of souls on board is less than 40.

Large Aircraft – Number of souls on board is greater than or equal to 40.

Water Incidents – As a general rule, F72 will be used when victims have actually entered the body of water. F73 will be used while victims are still aboard the vessel.

Appliance Fire (contained) – A fire that consumes the interior product area only. Appliance is defined as a device or machine used primarily in the home to carry out a specific function, such as food preparation or care of laundry.
