RESOLUTION NO. 1-2022

A RESOLUTION OF DAUPHIN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS INCREASING COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN ELECTION WORKERS

WHEREAS, elections by the people are the backbone of the democracy which is the cornerstone of our freedom and government and which provides the legitimacy to the same; and

WHEREAS, the voting district election officials are vital to the operation and legitimacy of such elections; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Election Code calls for the County Board of Elections, in each County of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to designate the compensation for the positions of Judge of Elections, Inspectors of Elections, Clerks and Machine Operators in each voting district within the maximum and minimum compensations set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, election workers work on Election Day for a period in excess of the thirteen (13) hours during which the polls are open; and

WHEREAS, the current rate of compensation for Judges of Election in Dauphin County is \$170,00, the current rate of compensation for Inspectors of Election in Dauphin County is \$140.00, and the current rate of compensation for Clerks and Machine Operators in Dauphin County is \$130.00, as set forth by Resolution #01-2018.

NOW THEREFORE, the Dauphin County Board of Elections, in accordance with 25 P.S. Section 2682-2, hereby sets the compensation for the following election officials, effective January 1, 2023, and continuing until such time as the matter is subsequently addressed by the Board, as follows:

Judge of Elections	Compensation of \$200.00 per Election Day
Inspectors of Election	Compensation of \$175.00 per Election Day
Clerks and Machine Operators	Compensation of \$150.00 per Election Day



