WHO MUST REGISTER?

Any person or company that collects processes, transports, or disposes of municipal solid waste ("MSW") generated in Dauphin County.

TERMS OF REGISTRATION:

By completing and signing the Application, the Registrant hereby understands, acknowledges, and agrees to abide by the Dauphin County Rules and Regulations, Dauphin County Waste Ordinance, and provisions of the Dauphin County Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan, and furthermore to provide any and all documentation requested by the County for compliance purposes.

In consideration of the County's Registration issuance, the Applicant agrees to indemnify and defend the County for any cost, damage, claim, liability, assessment, penalty, loss and/or expense incurred, directly or indirectly by reason of act or omissions by the undersigned Applicant, its agents and employees, including but not limited to any violation of the Dauphin County Rules and Regulations, Dauphin County Waste Ordinance, and the Dauphin County Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan, or any provision of the 2024 Waste Hauler Registration Application.

The Applicant agrees to fulfill the Waste Hauler registration requirements upon issuance of a Registration Certificate.

Waste Hauler registrations that are issued will be valid from January 1 – December 31, 2025.

Commonwealth of PA – Title 25 / Environmental Protection DEFINITION:

§271.1 Municipal Waste – garbage, refuse, industrial lunchroom or office waste and other material, including solid, liquid, semi-solid or contained gaseous material resulting from operation of residential, municipal, commercial, or institutional establishments and from community activities; and sludge not meeting the definition of residual or hazardous waste under this section from a municipal, commercial, or institutional water supply treatment plant, waste water treatment plant or air pollution control facility.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION WASTE

Definition 271.1 Construction/demolition waste — Solid waste resulting from the construction or demolition of buildings and other structures, including, but not limited to, wood, plaster, metals, asphaltic substances, bricks, block and unsegregated concrete. The term does not include the following if they are separate from other waste and are used as clean fill:

- i. Uncontaminated soil, rock, stone, gravel, brick and block, concrete and used asphalt; and
- ii. Waste from land clearing, grubbing and excavation, including trees, brush, stumps and vegetative material.

Management of Construction and Demolition Waste

Salvaging - By definition, materials salvaged for use in their intended function are not wastes. Such as bathroom fixtures, ceiling panels, doors, flooring, lighting fixtures, windows, etc. Source separated recyclable materials are also not wastes. For construction, renovation and demolition activities this includes: cardboard, glass, metals, paper and plastics.

Disposal – Any permitted disposal facility accepting construction and demolition wastes.
