RESOLUTION NO. 49-2010

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CREATION OF A HUMAN SERVICE TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the counties of Cumberland, Dauphin, and Perry have mutually agreed to propose a pilot project to improve human service transportation delivery in the three county region and make it more sustainable over the long-run pursuant to a July 2009 study on this subject conducted under Act 44 of 2007 and submit its findings to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's Bureau of Public Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the three counties have formed a Human Services Transportation (HST) Committee that will meet and develop common objectives and align efforts on a regional basis on key issues relative thereto; and

WHEREAS, the HST Committee intends to develop and design a system that will improve service efficiency, customer service, cost control, system management, establish new / enhanced methods of service delivery, provide an opportunity to enhance coordination between State agencies, improve HST program management, reporting and outcome measurement, while continuing to allow local entities to determine an approach that meets both state and local needs; and

WHEREAS, the HST Committee proposes to build a mobility management system for the three county region that will serve as a transferable model for other regions of the Commonwealth to replicate, and

WHEREAS, the HST Committee is committed to planning efforts focused beyond an initial pilot phase and will establish on-going goals and objectives for three, five, and ten year improvements in regional services, and

WHEREAS, the three county HST Committee intends to ensure any change that comes about is based on quantifiable data and information and intends to only make changes where changes are necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA THAT:

Dauphin County supports the establishment and goals of the Human Services Transportation Committee Pilot Project and all appropriate County staff are hereby authorized to participate in said pilot project.
