

RESOLUTION #- 3-2011

WHEREAS, the Keystone Human Service has presented plans to construct either a new building or rehabilitate an existing property to serve as a new administrative headquarters for the integrated delivery of human service programs to the Dauphin County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Dauphin County Board of Commissioners wish to support the Keystone Human Services-Services sites and administrative office for being an asset to the community and a well needed human health service provider in our region.

WHEREAS, the Keystone Human Services has obtained a grant for \$1,000,000 through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Redevelopment Assistance Capital Project funding (RACP) to be matched by a \$950,000 bridge bank loan; and

WHEREAS, the Keystone Human Services Department has independently of Dauphin County obtained its \$950,000 matching share and has control over the same; and

WHEREAS, RACP funding requires local municipal entity participation.

KEYSTONE HUMAN SERVICES

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dauphin County Board of Commissioners endorses the Keystone Human Services -Services sites and administrative office construction project and directs appropriate county officers, employees and agents to assist in obtaining RACP funding at no cost to the county through the execution of various documents and other reasonable and appropriate actions as necessary.
