## RESOLUTION No. <u>/3</u>-2012

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by
Act No. 137 of 1992 authorized counties to establish County Affordable Housing Funds to
increase the availability of quality housing, either through sales or rental, to any county resident
whose annual income qualifies for such program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Dauphin County enacted Ordinance
No. 2-1994 establishing the Dauphin County Affordable Housing Fund, and by Resolution No.
8-1994 the Board of Commissioners of Dauphin County established the Dauphin County
Affordable Housing Fund Board to draft and recommend to the Commissioners guidelines for
the use of the Affordable Housing Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Dauphin County authorized the Dauphin County Department of Community and Economic Development to administer the Dauphin County Affordable Housing Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Dauphin County Affordable Housing Trust Fund Board has proposed continuation of the Dauphin County Rental Assistance Program for an additional three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the approximate cost of the Rental Assistance Program will be Eighty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$89,700), including administrative costs; and WHEREAS, the Dauphin County Affordable Housing Trust Fund Board has established eligibility criteria and procedures for carrying out the Rental Assistance Program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE board of Commissioners of Dauphin County that:

- 1. The Dauphin County Rental Assistance Program shall be continued for an additional three (3) years at the approximate cost of Eighty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$89,700.00), including administrative costs effective January 1, 2012.
- 2. Guadenzia Delta Community will work with thirty (30) Dauphin County families over the three (3) year period of program.
- 3. Rental assistance will be provided to the thirty (30) families as part of their ongoing case management and self sufficiency program with Guadenzia Delta Community
- 4. The eligibility requirements for participation in the County Rental Assistance
  Program will be developed and implemented by the Dauphin County Affordable Housing Trust
  Fund Board.

5. The procedures for op	eration of the Dauphin County Rental Assistance
Program will be developed and impleme	ented by the Dauphin County Affordable Housing Trust
Fund Board.
