DAUPHIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

RESOLUTION NO. 29-2020

As a result of the 2020 pandemic, the County had made the decision to furlough some of its employees. If an employee was an active member of the pension fund and did not receive a paycheck due to a furloughed status, they will not receive credit for those 14 days for computing membership service for retirement purposes only.

WHEREAS, Section 12 of Act 96 (County Pension Law) allows participants to buyback furloughed time;

WHEREAS, the time during which a member is absent from service on leave without pay may be counted in computing the service of a contributor, if allowed by the county commissioners and approved by the board;

WHEREAS, The Retirement Board on December 9, 2020 approved said buyback;

Now therefore, be it resolved as follows:

The employees who are active members of the pension fund and did not receive paychecks during calendar year of 2020 shall have the opportunity to buy back the furloughed time with respect to their pensions

The Retirement Coordinator will notify each affected employee in writing as to the amount of furloughed time they can purchase and the calculated purchase price. Payment can be made lump sum by personal check or money order or by an authorized payroll wage attachment. No employment taxes are deferred from the purchase price.

The purchase of furloughed time must be done in calendar year 2021 with a deadline to complete the purchase being 12/31/2021.
