RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
AUTHORIZING REFUNDS, STRIKE-OFFS, AND/OR EXONERATION OF COUNTY
TAXES PAID OR DUE FOR TAX YEARS INCLUDING 2017 AND 2018 LEVIES TO
HOWARD HENRY FOR VARIOUS CITY PROPERTIES LISTED HEREIN BASED
UPON EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES

WHEREAS, in May of 2016, following the collapse of the Mulberry Street Bridge,
several properties owned by Howard Henry suffered nearly irreparable damage; and

WHEREAS, the County through the Commissioners has determined that a specific
location has suffered damage known as follows:


- 09-042-019 Property Location: 147 S. Cameron Street

- 02-010-023 Property Location: 201-203 S. Cameron Street
- 02-010-024 Property Location: 205-235 S. Cameron Street

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners deem it appropriate to provide assistance to the
citizen within the area of the collapsed bridge who shall be issued refunds or strike-offs
of his County taxes paid or due for tax year 2017 and exonerations or refunds for 2018
County tax levies; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be passed in
accordance with the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery
Assistance Program.
