

Rule 5103. Custody of Exhibits. Special Provisions.

(a) Documentary Exhibits: Generally

- (1) If a document is larger than 8-1/2 x 11 inches, the Court Reporter shall be provided with a copy of the same sized 8-1/2 x 11 inches. Items larger than 8-1/2 x 11 may be used for illustration during the court proceeding.
- (2) Media depositions presented at trial shall remain in the proponent's possession. The proponent shall simultaneously submit a transcript of the deposition as an exhibit.

(c) Non-documentary Exhibits: Generally

- (3) If the exhibit is bulky or oversized, either the Court Reporter or the proponent shall maintain custody of the exhibit as directed by the Court.
