RESOLUTION NO. 29-2014

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN ELECTION DISTRICT OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the election district officers are vital to the operation and legitimacy of elections; and

WHEREAS, election officers work on Election Day for a period in excess of the thirteen (13) hours during which the polls are open; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Election Code provides that the County Board of Elections, in each County of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, shall fix the compensation for the positions of Judge of Elections, Inspectors of Elections, Clerks and Machine Operators in each election district within certain parameters, 25 P.S. § 2682.2; and

WHEREAS, the current rate of compensation for Judges of Election in Dauphin County is \$125.00, the current rate of compensation for Inspectors of Election in Dauphin County is \$115.00, and the current rate of compensation for Clerks and Machine Operators in Dauphin County is \$115.00, as set by Dauphin County Election Board Resolution 24-2006;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE DAUPHIN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS THAT:

The compensation of the following election officers, effective as of the Municipal Primary on May 19, 2015 and for every election thereafter until such time as the matter is further addressed by the Election Board, is hereby fixed at:

Judge of Elections\$150.00 per Election DayInspectors of Election\$125.00 per Election DayClerks and Machine Operators\$115.00 per Election Day

ADOPTED this 17th day of December, 2014, by the Board of Elections of the County of Dauphin, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled.
