

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

AND NOW, this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January 2023, upon consideration of the recent increase in permitted maximum monthly professional guardianship fees in Medicaid cases from \$100 per month to \$300 per month that is effective January 1, 2023, all currently serving Dauphin County court-appointed professional guardians who had previously been authorized by the Court to receive monthly compensation of \$100 per month from Medicaid in Dauphin County guardianship cases are now authorized to receive \$300 per month from Medicaid without the need to file a petition seeking the increased fee. Notice of this Order shall be posted on the Dauphin County website and a copy of this order shall be sent to all court-appointed professional guardians by the Dauphin County Clerk of the Orphans' Court.
